



General tendencies

Total acreage remains constant but major shifts:



- Pear is replacing apple 'Jonagold in crisis'
- High interest for cherry but...
 - * Little Cherry Virus
 - * Drosophila suzukii
- High interest in small fruits
 - * Strawberry : increasing
 - * Raspberry : strong increase
 - * Blackberry: slight increase
 - * Blueberry: increasing
 - * Red currant: slight decrease
 - * kiwi berry (Hardy kiwi) constant
- Viticulture: +20%/year (300 ha)
- 23 June 2016: severe storm in main production area with lots of fruit and infrastructural damage

Novel research themes in PCFRUIT




St-Truiden, Belgium

(proven results by multiyear experiments or finished projects)






Other...

- Launch of Platform (app) for Registration and Decision Support
- Remote sensing by drones for fire blight detection, drought stress, production estimates, ...
- Organic production and biodiversity
- Reduce nitrate leaching and N-residue in soil
- Better understanding of N-fertilization (strawberry, pear): uptake, transport in the plant, fruit quality, organic matter,...
- Integrated approach fire blight control
- Emerging pest and diseases: Stemphilium, Pestalotiopsis,
 Drosophila suzukii, Little Cherry Virus, ...
