National Rural Development Program 2014-2020 Measures for Fruit growing investments – 300 milions Berries – high demand:

- blueberry
- chokeberry (Aronia melanocarpa)
- Go Ji (Lycium barbarum)





- High demand:

- walnut no clonal propagated trees available
- sea buckthorn mainly for organic and export

Mediterranean fruit fly (MFF) - *Ceratitis capitata* Wiedemann (*Diptera, Tephritidae*), EPPO code CERTCA, A2 no. 105

One of the most significant quarantine pests for the EPPO region !

Stanciu, 2007 - Diospyros kaki

Chireceanu *et al.* 2013, * under 10% affected jujube fruits, * the adults were collected from September to October, * the first adult captured just when the jujube fruits start to ripe



Brown marmorated stink bug (BMSB) - *Halyomorpha halys* Stal (*Heteroptera: Pentatomidae*). EPPO code HALYHA, formerly EPPO Alert List till 2013

Invasive pest in USA, under observation in the EPPO regions!

Macavei *et al.*, 2015 - in Bucharest, on ornamentals and *Cucurbitaceae*

We found in September and October 2016 adults feeding on apple and jujube fruits. Status: under observation !



Southern Green Stink Bug - Nezara viridula L (Heteroptera: Pentatomidae) EPPO code NEZAVI,

A relative new invasive species Europe

Preda & Skolka, 2009, Constanța

Since 2011, in Romania, started produce major damage on tomatoes and other vegetables, also on corn and goji.





Citrus flatid plant-hopper - *Metcalfa pruinosa* **Say** (*Homoptera: Flatidae*), EPPO code: METFPR, no list
