

The consortium comprises internationally renowned academic groups with extensive experience in plant breeding, plantgenomics, and plant metabolite profiling, as well as innovative small and medium-sized technology companies active in the berry-breeding sector.

IPLANTA CHALLENGES

- a) Evaluation of the efficacy of the RNA molecules to be used for the induction of disease and pest resistance and metabolic changes in plants.
- b) Examination of the specificity of the selected miRNAs and siRNAs and their impacts on both target and non-target/off-target systems.
- c) Development of specific risk assessment and risk management guidelines which relate to the target and non-target effects of the miRNAs and siRNAs on food, feed and the environment.
- d) Improvement of the specificity of the selected RNA molecules.
- e) Understanding the modes of transmission, uptake, systemic spread and degradation of dsRNAs, mi-RNAs and siRNAs in target and nontarget organisms.
- f) Determination of the environmental and socio-economic impacts of plant RNAi technology and products.
- g) Compare efficiency, risk and benefits of RNAi against gene/genome editing technologies.
